SECTION 2: Evaluation Approach

SECTION 3: Pricing Information

Pricing information to be provided by suppliers.

In submitting the price, the supplier must meet the following:

- a. The pricing schedule must show a breakdown of all costs, fees, expenses and charges associated with the full delivery of the requirements over the whole of the life of the contract. It must also clearly state the total contract price exclusive of VAT.
- b. In preparing their quote, suppliers are to consider all risks, contingencies and other circumstances relating to the delivery of the requirements and include adequate provision in the quote and pricing information to manage such risks and contingencies.
- c. Prices should be tendered in Euro (€) Ex-VAT.
- d. Suppliers must state if they are VAT registered
- e. Suppliers if successful must provide a Tax Clearance Cert. TCC, and complete a bank mandate form to facilitate EFT.
